

Results of the 2017 CIDOC Survey of documentation technology

Documentation technology is in constant evolution: new technologies emerge, and new applications are found for existing technologies. Some developments prove to have long-term value while others quickly fall out of favour. Originally initiated by UNESCO, the *survey of documentation technology* is an ongoing initiative whose aim is to identify emergent trends and provide the cultural heritage community with insights about successful and potential applications, costs, drawbacks and limitations – allowing informed decisions about future investment.

This short presentation gives an overview of the results obtained since the survey opened in 2017.
