Different views for different needs: A model for data preservation and representation.

In an increasingly complex technical environment for archaeologists, the need is emerging both for more complex research data, as well as for cooperating with traditional "cultural heritage" institutions for publishing our archaeological collections to the public, in the form of museum collections. We will outline the problems we have experienced in meeting both the need for preservation of existing excavation data and for a more popular presentation of the same data. Our approach involves a pragmatic repository for mixed research data, as well as a mapping model for representing a simplified view of this data when integrating with CH-oriented systems.
